How would you work with the private sector to spur more housing production? Are you supportive of public-private partnerships like the multifamily tax exemption program and downpayment assistance?
- 5. Crime is increasing in Washington State and Clark County. Define what your thoughts are on public safety, how do we keep neighborhoods, people, and businesses safe long term?
- 6. How would you effectively communicate and collaborate with other jurisdictions?
