- 2. How should our community respond to homelessness? How do you feel about the City of Vancouver's response?
- 3. How do we improve public safety in our community? What is your threshold for law enforcement involvement?
- 4. If elected, and within the context of your office, how would you improve housing affordability and supply for all housing types, including single family homes?
- 5. What is your professional experience (public/private), how does your experience inform your beliefs, and how will this help you represent the people of Clark County?
- 6. Given the polarization of American politics, how will you work with citizens, stakeholders, staff, and fellow policy makers to accomplish policy goals? How would you decrease polarization in politics?
- 7. How much has your campaign raised and what types of marketing, volunteering, and promotion encompass your campaign?
- 8. What is your perspective on taxation? How do we fund public services while creating a fertile business environment to attract new businesses and residents?
- 9. How would you approach short term rentals (Airbnb, etc.), what additional regulation would you prescribe, if any?
- 10. What are your thoughts on the I-5 Interstate Bridge Replacement (IBR)?
- 11. What are your thoughts on the Growth Management Act?
- 12. Do you support the rights and employment of qualified independent contractors, regardless of industry? If elected, how would you support these business owners?
- 13. Give us an example of a moment of failure in your life or career, how did you recover and what did you learn from it?
